I cannot wait to see your smile again when I am home.

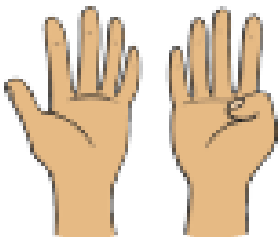
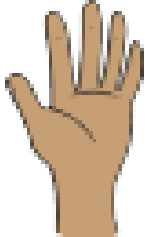
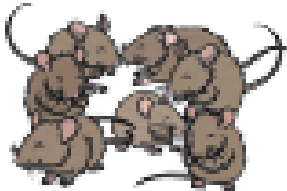
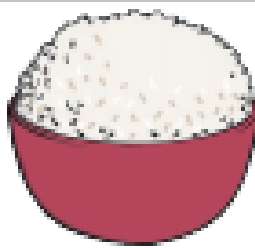

We let her eat fish for a week. What a smart cat!

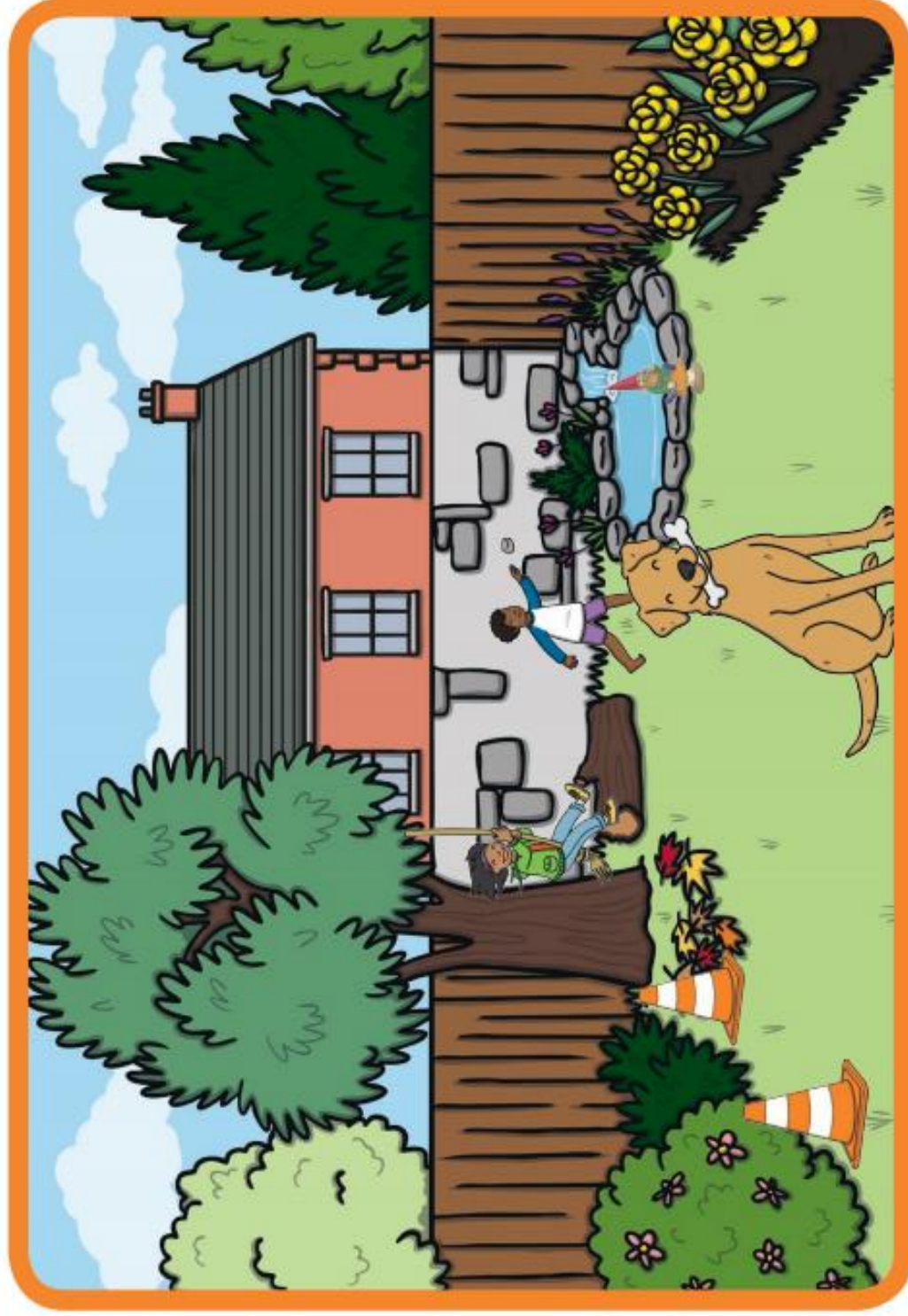
