- Create a piece of art work based on your half-term week. You can use any medium you like. The art work can be 2D or 3D.

- Learn to count in a different language – how many numbers can you learn and recall? Can you count in 2's & 5's? Can you count backwards?
- Bake or cook something for your family (you may need to ask for assistance with this from an adult).
- Give yourself a sporting challenge, i.e. How many keepie-uppies can you do? How long can you hula-hoop for?
