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SCHOOL GUIDANCE ON SUSPECTED CASE WHILST IN SCHOOL

Suspected case in child

- If the child becomes unwell whilst at school they should be taken to the meeting room. If the meeting room is engaged the room should be vacated.
- Member of staff should use the First Aid PPE held in the meeting room/office.
- Temperature of the child should be taken. If this high then parent should be contacted and sent home.
- If child has a high temperature, persistent cough or loss of taste/smell
- Parent should arrange for a test to take place.
- If the child has a sibling then they will also have to go home
- When the child has gone home the meeting room should be thoroughly cleaned and any items disposed of or well washed.

Suspected case in staff

- If the staff member becomes unwell whilst at school they should be sent home and then they or the school will arrange for a test.

Result of test

- Negative for COVID-19: Case can return once well. Contacts can stop self-isolating and carry on as normal.
- Positive: Ensure child/staff member isolates at home for 10 days (days of onset PLUS 9 days). The rest of the household need to isolate for 14 days.
- If further suspected or confirmed cases occur within this group, they need to isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms.
- Any siblings also in the same setting would need to isolate at this point.
- Cases and contacts can return once the isolation period is completed.
