Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to those parents that have returned permission slips and contributed towards the Tate Modern. Please do make the contribution as although the school heavily subsidises these trips the only way they are viable is if parents make contributions.

Please find below a reminder of the arrangements:

Monday 7th November 2022

- Years 1, 2 and 3 to arrive at school for 7.45am and to be registered in class. They will be departing at about 8.00am. They should arrive back at the school at approximately 16.30 (traffic permitting).

Tuesday 8th November 2022

- Years 4, 5 and 6 to arrive at school for 7.30am and to be registered in class. They will be departing at about 7.45am. They should be arriving back at school at approximately 16.30 (traffic permitting).

There will be two coaches taking the children up (53 on each). They will be parked along the road outside the school so please be mindful that access will be more difficult. We will cone the road to stop parents parking but please do not block the road off.

The school will text when we arrive. We will also text when we depart the gallery and we will text an approximate ETA on route. If we are delayed we will update you of our progress via text messages. If children do not arrive on time in the morning the coaches will unfortunately not be able to wait.

If a child struggles with travel sickness parents are asked to inform the class teacher on the morning of travel. If they need tablets administering, then parents must complete a medication form and provide clearly named travel sickness tablets. Medication forms will be available from the class teacher.

Children will need to wear school uniform and comfortable shoes. They should have a bag that can hold packed lunches and drinks. No valuables should be brought, however if children wish to bring books, cards or small games for the coach journey that will be fine. No fizzy drinks or sweets should

be brought. We will not be visiting the gift shop on either day.

Visits are a fantastic way for the children to learn from valuable experiences. We know that this trip will be a great way to start Art Week.
