



The Russia/Ukraine Conflict



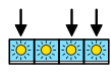
Russia has started a conflict with Ukraine.



Russia and Ukraine are not near where we live.



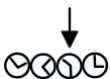
Boris Johnson is using words and telling Russia to stop.

They try to make an agreement and solve the problem.



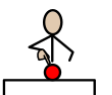
Sometimes, they might have a disagreement that ends in a conflict. This is



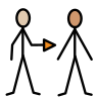

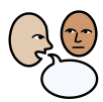





 You could share your worries, speak to an adult and tell them how

 show you are thinking about them.

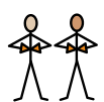


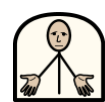





 Hopefully, Russia and Ukraine will solve the disagreement soon.
