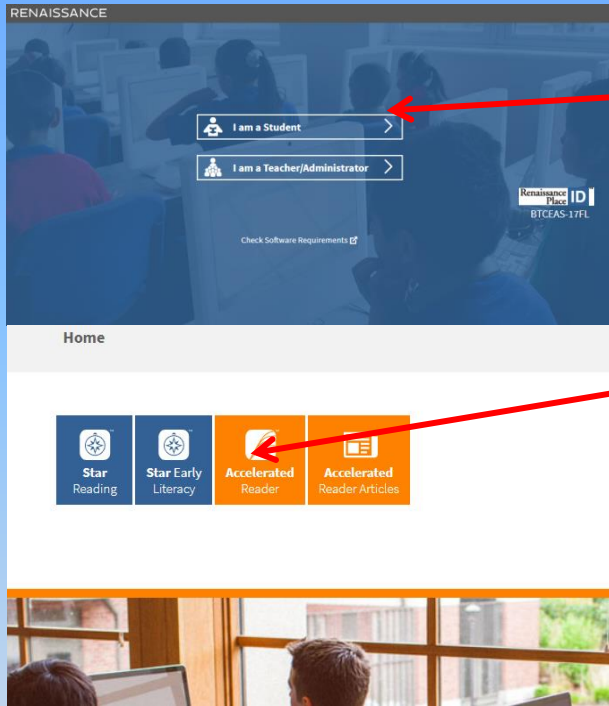

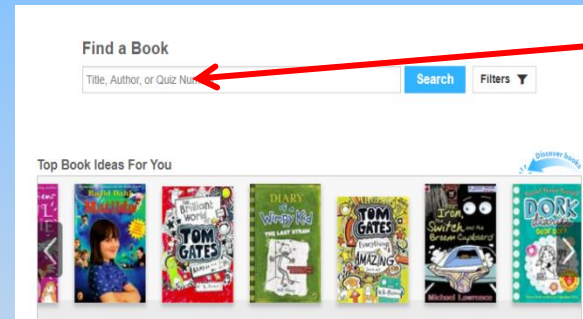

Click on Accelerated reader.



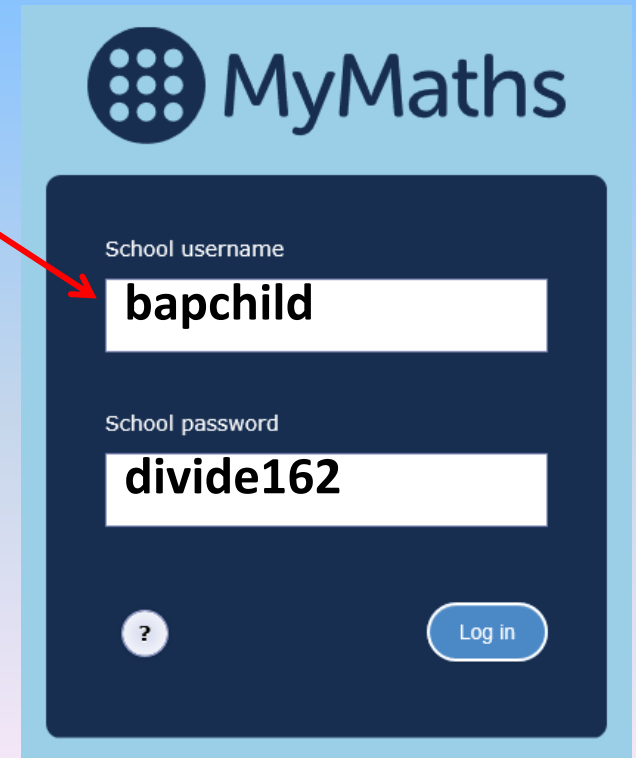
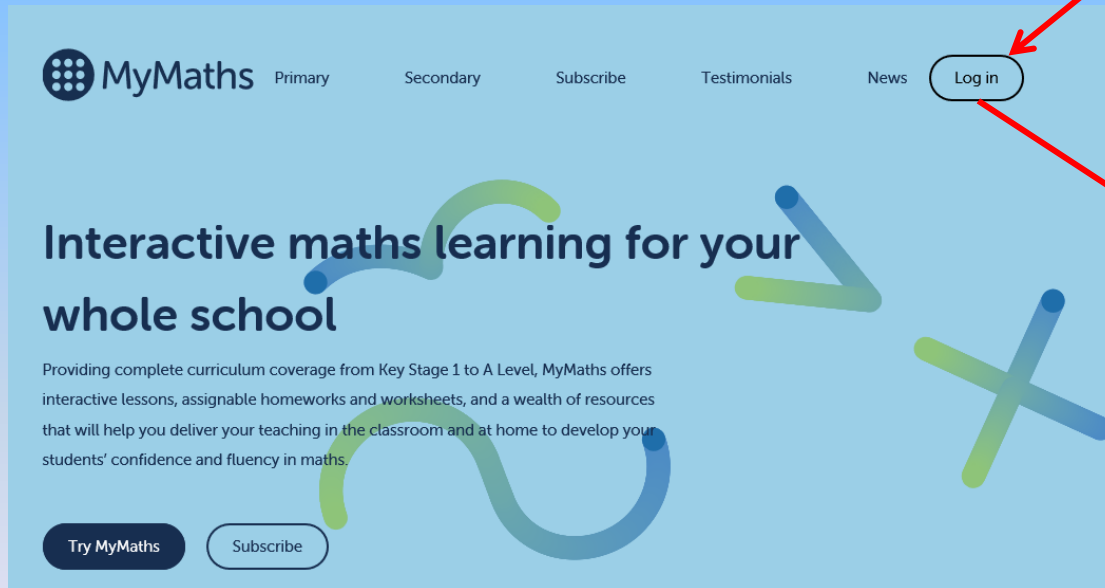
Type in the name the book or the quiz number.
