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Dear Parents

As you may be aware following the Government's announcement on Monday about remaining at Stage 3 of the Roadmap out of Lockdown, I wanted to update you about the plans specifically for Sport Days and the range of activities and events that we have got planned for the remainder of the academic year.

All of the events that have been planned can be undertaken in a socially distanced manner but this does mean that all parents and visitors must continue to follow the measures and procedures that we have or will put in place. We also want to ensure that you get to see your child/ren doing the things that we all love such as sports day.

As you will be aware from the calendar, we have Sports events arranged on Monday 5th July and Tuesday 6th July 2021. These are:

- Monday 5th July 2021 – 9.30 am – 10.45 am - Nursery and Reception
- Monday 5th July 2021 – 1.30 pm – 2.45 pm – Years 1 and 2
- Tuesday 6th July 2021 – 9.30 am – 10.45 am - Years 3 and 4
- Tuesday 6th July 2021 – 1.30 pm – 2.45 pm - Years 5 and 6

These events will have specific risk assessments detailing potential risks and methods to mitigate these so that parents/carers can join. We must also work within the current Government guidance which does present some challenges but should not preclude us from not doing them. To ensure that we are successful we have the following measures that are in place:

- Only two members of the household will be able to attend. If there are younger siblings they may attend but must stay with the parents and not run around playing. If parents have children in other year groups, the parent can go to any of the other sports mornings/afternoons for their child but can only join one bubble at each time. For example, if you have children in Years 1 and 2 you will only be able to join the Year 1 bubble **or** the Year 2 bubble.
- Each year group will be divided in half according to their house group for the field events and then come back together for the track events. So that parents can view field events they will be allocated a house/year group bubble with a maximum of 30 adults in each bubble. This means that if all parents attend there will be two bubbles per year group.



- Parents must adhere to the 2m social distancing rule and when moving around we ask that they wear a mask. No parent will be able to move across bubbles e.g. from the Year 1 to 2 bubble.
- The school needs to be able to effectively track and trace parents who attend. We are therefore asking you to complete the forms detailing who will be attending (one form per year group if you have more than one child). We will then track who has attended.
- Unfortunately, no parents will be able to attend a picnic lunch afterwards or before which is the normal tradition.
- Parents should bring their own chairs to sit on and should not sit in groups, maintain the 2m distance from each other unless sat with their family member. They should regularly use the hand sanitiser made available. No toilets will be available for parents/other children.
