Oxford Owl

Children and parents can read together by accessing a range of books using Oxford Owl. There are a range of books available here for ages 3-11. You'll need to create your own login to use Oxford Owl, if you haven't already.

Accelerated Reader

Children in KS2 are still able to access Accelerated Reader (AR) to complete quizzes on reading books at home. To access AR, the children must log in using their login on this link first:

Teachers will post this link on google classroom. From here, the children can complete quizzes as they usually would in class. The children will use their usual login of the first initial of their first name, followed by the first 4 initials of their last name (e.g.: phort), their password should be ABC or DEF. If you have any problems with logins then please contact your class teachers via google classroom.

Alongside this, this week we will be launching the 'Get Caught Reading!' challenge. The aim of this challenge is to show regular reading in different and exciting places.
