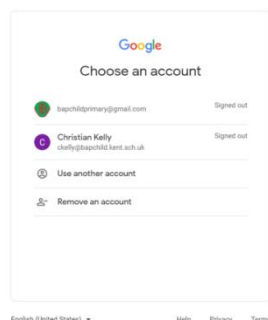
How to join a Google Hangout

1. All children have a Google Account managed by school. To log-in you need to access, through Chrome, your child's account.

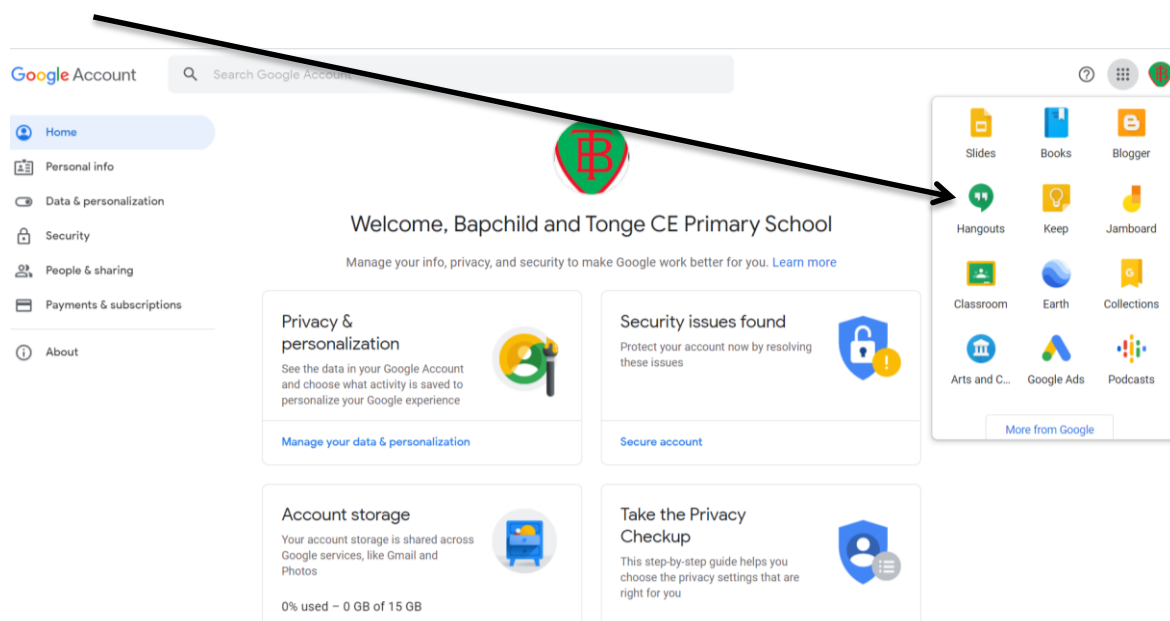
