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Dear Year 4 Parents and Carers

I hope you and your families are well and keeping safe.

We have been considering a range of options available to us to provide some face-to-face sessions for your child. This would be for the last three weeks of term starting from Monday 29th June – Friday 19th July, 2020. We are also planning for a transition session with your child's new class teacher on Monday 21st or Tuesday 22nd July but will write to you separately about this.

We are working on plans for children to return in small groups (maximum 15 per group size) and to have the opportunity to work with their class teachers. Sessions will be about 2 hours long with one per week either in the morning or afternoon. Due to logistics it is not possible to set them on the same day each week and it maybe that they are offered a morning session one week and then an afternoon session the next week. It will also not be possible to have siblings on the same day or session time due to reduced school capacity.

These sessions will give the children the opportunity to share home learning, have new activities set, change reading books and play. Although we recognise these are for short periods of time it will give your child the opportunity to come back to school before the summer break and valuable social time.

If you are interested in them returning, please complete the survey below expressing your interest. We will then write to you again with arrangements for your child but only if you reply to the survey. The survey will close at midday on Monday 22nd June 2020.
