Dear Parent/Carer,

The School Public Health Teams at Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust routinely offer vision and hearing screening to all children in reception class. The screening will be carried out from 2nd March 2020 till the end of the summer term. Your child will be seen in a small group of 3 to 4 children within the school.

The results of the screening will be sent home within 4 weeks of the screening being completed. Please ensure that your child's school has an up to date address and contact number for you to ensure the results letter is sent to the correct address or that we can contact you by phone if required.

If there are concerns with your child's vision we will refer them to the orthoptist for a follow up appointment. If there is a concern with your child's hearing we will re-screen again in 12-14 weeks and if required will refer them for a follow up appointment with audiology.

There are some cases when children will not be screened:

- If your child is receiving treatment for a vision problem or wears glasses they will not have their vision screened.
- If your child is receiving treatment for a hearing problem or wears hearing aids they will not have their hearing screened.

If your child is undergoing treatment for either a vision or hearing problem, please inform us using either the email address or telephone number at the top of this letter by 24th February 2020. You will need to provide us with your child's name, address, date of birth, school name and address.

If you are happy for your child to have their hearing and vision checked you do not need to contact us.

If your child is absent on the day of screening we will attempt to see them again in school, if this is not possible we will invite you to attend a community clinic.

Opting your child out of the hearing and vision programme

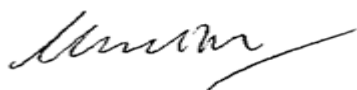
