As the end of the year approaches, it seems to become more and more busy and we wanted to clarify a few of the arrangements for some of the events that are coming up.

Sports Mornings

Key Stage 2 Sports Morning will be on Tuesday 18th June beginning at 10.00 am on the field. Some parents like to arrive earlier to set up seats and the gates will be open from drop-off. We start with the field events where each class goes to a field event e.g. javelin, and then once complete goes to another. Following a short break the track events start with a range of running races. Our younger children tend to join partway through to cheer the children on. Following the conclusion of the races and washing of hands parents and relatives are welcome to stay for a picnic on the field with their children. School dinners are still provided and available.

Key Stage 1 Sports Morning will be on Wednesday 19th June beginning at 10.00 am on the field. Again parents can set up seats from drop-off time. The children start with a range of field activities and following a short break, the track events start with a range of running races. Our older children join to cheer the children on. We will then announce the winner overall and then after washing of hands, parents and relatives are welcome to stay for a picnic on the field with their children. School dinners are still provided and available.

On both days the children are expected to return to class for the afternoon session. We have reserve days organised, in case of bad weather, on Tuesday 25th June (KS2) and Wednesday 26th June (KS1).
