As part of this year's Rainbow themed Art Week we are planning to take Years 1 to 6 to Tate Modern in London to be inspired by the dramatic gallery buildings and the finest collections of International and Contemporary Art. Years 1 to 3 will go on Tuesday 6 November and Years 4 to 6 on Wednesday 7 November.

Our trips always have a high adult to child ratio and detailed risk assessments. We take the latest advice from the Local Authority and notify them of our visits and plans.

We will be leaving school at 8.15am on the day so ask all children to arrive promptly at 8.00am to register. We will be aiming to arrive back at school at 4.30pm and will text if we are going to be early or delayed.

The children will need to wear school uniform, suitable walking shoes and a waterproof jacket or coat. Packed lunches, a snack and non-fizzy drink will be required.

The school will be subsidising the cost of the trip but we would like to ask you to make a voluntary contribution of £15.50. If you could please complete the form below and return to the school as soon as possible.

This trip will be an important focus for Art Week and will be a valuable and memorable experience for our school community. As well as the gallery visit, there will also be the opportunity to view the London skyline from the Millennium Bridge, plus 360° views of the city from the top of the Tate.
